1. This Specific Procurement Notice follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for this project that appeared in UNDB online **AfDB41-01/15 dated 22 January 2017** and on the African Development Bank Group's Internet Website.

The Kingdom of Lesotho has received a grant from the African Development Bank Group in the amount of **UA 2.6 million** towards the cost of **Institutional Support for Public Financial Management Project (ISEP)**. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this grant to cover eligible payments under the contract for Procurement of equipment for Integrated Financial Management Information Systems (IFMIS).
3. The Ministry of Finance now invites sealed bids from prospective bidders for the **Supply, Installation and Commissioning of UPS, Networking Cabling and Power Skirting, Switches and Integrated Services Router** packaged under three (3) lots as listed below:
